Geneva Science and Diplomacy Anticipator (GESDA) and Kyoto Institute of Philosophy (KIP) Sign Landmark Partnership in Kyoto to Advance Collaboration Around Science Anticipation, Philosophy, GESDA Planetarised Humanity framework and KIP's concept of a Multilayered Society of Values.

Kyoto, Japan, 25/09/2025

The Geneva Science and Diplomacy Anticipator (GESDA) and the Kyoto Institute of Philosophy (KIP) have officially signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) in Kyoto, marking a significant partnership aimed at advancing interdisciplinary collaboration between science anticipation and philosophy. This new alliance seeks to harness cutting-edge scientific breakthroughs alongside philosophical insights to address critical questions about humanity, society, and the future of our planet.

The MOU highlights the commitment of both institutions to foster values-centered approaches that explore fundamental issues such as human identity, social coexistence, and planetary sustainability.

Drawing on KIP's concept of a Multilayered Society of Values and GESDA's Planetarised Humanity framework, the two organizations agreed to jointly seek "a more powerful connection between scientific discovery, philosophical analysis, and its impact on the human condition and social coexistence." Collaboration areas include sharing networks and expertise, identifying strategic alignments between the two organizations, and informing potential new focus areas through regular consultations and joint planning.

This partnership between GESDA and KIP represents a bold step forward in strengthening the connection between science, philosophy, business and diplomacy on the global stage. Together, the two organizations aim to inspire new ways of thinking that promote sustainable and inclusive futures for people and the planet.
